Description	
Description:	Checks whether a cargo drop from a plane, initiated using fn vbs cargo drop , has been completed.
Syntax	
Syntax:	[plane] call fn_vbs_cargo_status
Parameters:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">plane: Object - Plane which has been ordered to drop cargo.
Return Value:	Boolean - If true , then the plane is currently executing drops (or in the delay phase between dropped rows). If false , then the drop has been completed (even though the parachutes may still be in the air).
Warning	
When using functions in VBS versions older than 3.4 , certain limitations and requirements should be kept in mind - the main ones being that capitalization of the function name is crucial, and that #include "vbs2\headers\function_library.hpp" has to be included in every script that utilizes it.
