Description	
Description:	Removes the first (leftmost) element of an array and returns it. The array is modified by reference.
Syntax	
Syntax:	array call fn_vbs_arrayShift
Parameters:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">array: Array - Array to remove from. Note: Before <i>V1.30</i>, the array must be encased in brackets (in other words, the array must be in an array).
Return Value:	Array - Element removed from left of the array.
Warning	
When using functions in VBS versions older than 3.4 , certain limitations and requirements should be kept in mind - the main ones being that capitalization of the function name is crucial, and that #include "vbs2\headers\function_library.hpp" has to be included in every script that utilizes it.
