Description:	<p>Removes files from the watchlist specified in fileWatch.</p> <p>The filter for the file(s) to be removed does not have to match the one from fileWatch. It is possible to just remove a subset of files, while others are still being watched (for example, the following example script watches all *.log files, with the exception of backup.log):</p> <pre>fileWatch "*.log"; fileUnwatch "backup.log";</pre>

Syntax:	<code>fileUnwatch filter</code>
Parameters:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">filter: String - File name, or full path to file to remove from the watchlist. Typical windows wildcards (* or ?) can be used on the file name (but not the path). If no path is specified, then the installation folder is used.
